OUR ACHIEVEMENTS

Following the setting up of IloTNet within WP3, drafting the Transnational report and translating it into all partners' languages, the partnership proceeded with WP4 – Design of a specialized social media for IloT VET management and training, supporting trainees' employability and overcoming IloT skills gaps, as well as to facilitate the international cooperation among VET providers, SMEs and other stakeholders. This is the objective of WP4.

Based on the preliminary design of the IloTNet capacity building intervention, the partners developed **a specialized social network for IloTNet**. The aim of this common platform is to help in addressing the existing lack of information,

shared learning material, networking and peer learning in this area.

The ultimate goals are to enable networking between VET providers, SMEs, researchers, specialists, to create an online community of IloT practitioners and thus to support in the development of concepts, online and blended learning.

The Platform includes teaching materials, guidelines for VET providers, micro companies and SMEs and other stakeholders and good practice examples (in different areas, levels and types of education).

While WP3 was oriented towards strategic dynamics and priorities of capacity building of VET providers and streamlining of their business processes through IloTNet, WP4 is a forward-looking

and more ambitious capacity intervention based on international cooperation and the transfer of good models. The drive in the WP is to put in operation common specialized social media platform of a new generation of policies and tools that are otherwise not likely to reach the top of the VET providers' development agendas any time soon.

The WP is connected with other WPs through its communication and dissemination role in the project as it will spread the results of WP3, WP4, and WP5. The WP is linked to the remaining WPs because it is their subject for management, quality control and evaluation. In relation to the overall coordination of the project, the WP represents a gateway through which the project will communicate with stakeholders and thus ensure the project's recognition and sustainability through adoption/use of its results.
